PURPOSE OF REQUEST

The BOROUGH OF KENILWORTH is requesting proposals from qualified individuals and firms to provide **PLANNING BOARD ATTORNEY SERVICES** of a specialized nature to the BOROUGH. Proposals will be evaluated in accordance with the criteria set forth in this RFP. One or more individuals/firms may be selected to provide services.

PERIOD OF CONTRACT

January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.

CONTRACT FORM

The successful proposer shall be required to execute the BOROUGH'S form contract, which includes the indemnification, insurance, termination and licensing provisions.

It is also agreed and understood that the acceptance of the final payment by Contractor shall be considered a release in full of all claims against the BOROUGH arising out of, or by reason of, the work done and materials furnished under this Contract.

Public Notice

Borough of Kenilworth has adopted the Fair and Open Process of the Pay-to-Play Law (N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20A, et seq.) in its request for proposals and awarding goods and services contracts with an annual value in excess of \$17,500.00. Proposals will be evaluated by the Governing Body of the Borough of Kenilworth on the basis of the most advantageous, price and other factors considered. The evaluation will consider:

- a. Experience and reputation in the field;
- Knowledge of the Borough and the subject matter to be addressed under the contract.
- c. Availability to accommodate any required meetings of the Borough;
- d. Compensation proposal;
- e. Other factors if demonstrated to be in the best interest of the Borough.

In addition to the above criteria, the Borough may consider the following criteria, where applicable, in order to evaluate the proposal.

- a. Assurances of performance;
- b. Vendor's financial ability and strength to meet its obligations;
- c. How the costs compare to other proposals;
- d. If available, are suitable warranties and guarantees available.

To this end the Borough is seeking proposals for the following;

Planning Board Planner Services

NATURE/SCOPE OF SERVICES:

The Borough of Kenilworth is a legal, governmental entity. The Borough was incorporated in 1907. The Borough is governed by a Mayor and Council. The Borough Council sets policy, adopts the operating and capital budgets for the Borough, enacts ordinances and sets the direction of how the Borough of Kenilworth will provide government services. The Borough's population is approximately 7,675 and it consists of approximately 2.10 square miles of area. The Borough provides a full range of municipal services.

The Borough of Kenilworth is requesting proposals from qualified individuals and firms to provide Planning Board Counsel Services to represent the Borough in all planning related matters, including but not limited to, hearings held before the Planning Board. Applicants should demonstrate knowledge of general New Jersey planning and development law. Any experience or knowledge of matters directly affecting the Borough of Kenilworth should be addressed. The desired services include, but are not limited to the following: **PROFESSIONAL LEGAL SERVICES – PLANNING BOARD ATTORNEY**.

STANDARD REQUIREMENTS OF TECHNICAL PROPOSAL - Proposers should submit a technical proposal which contains the following:

- **A.** Number of copies required: one (1) original (signed in ink), one (1) copy and one (1) digital copy (*size should not exceed 10KB*) of each proposal shall be submitted.
- **B.** The name of the proposer, the principal place of business and, if different, the place where the services will be provided;
- **C.** Proposer must have a minimum of five (5) years experience in representing municipalities in planning issues;
- **D.** The education, qualifications, experience, and training of all person or persons who would primarily be assigned to provide these services, along with their names and titles
- **E.** A listing of all other engagements where services of the types being proposed were provided in the past. This should include this municipality and other municipal governments. Proposers shall list and demonstrate relevant experience and expertise in representing municipalities in planning issues.
- **F.** Please provide a description of any other area(s) of expertise in municipal law you or your firm may possess that have not been included in the response provided above.
- **G.** Please list any seminars given and/or articles written and published on any municipal law topics.
- **H.** Please list any offices held in any municipal or local government related legal organizations.
- I. A statement that neither the firm nor any individuals assigned to this engagement are disbarred, suspended, or otherwise prohibited from professional practice by any federal, state, or local agency;
- **J.** An Affirmative Action Statement (copy of form attached);
- **K.** A completed Non-Collusion Affidavit (copy of form attached);
- **L.** A completed Owner Disclosure Information form (copy of form attached);
- **M.** A statement that the proposer will comply with the General Terms and Conditions required by the Borough and enter into the Borough's standard Professional Services Contract;

<u>SPECIALIZED REQUIREMENTS OF TECHNICAL PROPOSAL</u> - Proposer must demonstrate extensive and concentrated experience and expertise in all facets of municipal planning issues.

<u>COST PROPOSAL</u> - Proposers should submit a cost proposal which should include any proposed retainer, the services to be provided for the retainer, if services will be provided at a flat rate, if all or any services will be billed through hourly rates and what are the established rate(s). The Borough does not provide payment for or reimbursement for travel expenses.

By submission of proposal, proposer acknowledges and agrees to adhere to the fee schedule set forth above.

<u>PROPOSAL EVALUATION</u> – The Borough will select the most advantageous proposals based on all of the evaluation factors set forth at the end of this RFP. The Borough will make the award(s) that is in the best interest of the Borough.

Each proposal must satisfy the objectives and requirements detailed in this RFP. The successful proposer shall be determined by an evaluation of the total content of the proposal submitted. The Borough reserves the right to:

- a. Not select any of the proposals;
- b. Select only portions of a particular proposer's proposal for further consideration; (However, proposers may specify portions of the proposal that they consider "bundled".)
- c. Award a contract for the requested services at any time within 60 days of the selection of the most advantageous proposal; Every proposal should be valid through this time period.

The Borough shall not be obligated to explain the results of the evaluation process to any proposer.

The Borough may require proposers to demonstrate any services described in their proposal prior to award.

PROPOSAL LIMITATIONS – This RFP is not intended to be an offer, order or contract and should not be regarded as such, nor shall any obligation or liability be imposed on the Borough by issuance of this RFP. The Borough reserves the right at the Borough's sole discretion to refuse any proposal submitted.

<u>USE OF INFORMATION</u> - Any specifications, drawings, sketches, models, samples, data, computer programs, documentation, technical or business information and the like ("Information") furnished or disclosed by the Borough to the proposer in connection with this RFP shall remain the property of the Borough. When in tangible form, all copies of such information shall be returned to the Borough upon request. Unless such information was previously known to the proposer, free of any obligation to keep it confidential, or has been or is subsequently made public by the Borough or a third party, it shall be held in confidence by the proposer, shall be

used only for the purposes of this RFP, and may not be used for other purposes except upon such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon in writing.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS -

- A. The Borough reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, if necessary, or to waive any informalities in the proposals, and, unless otherwise specified by the proposer, to accept any item, items or services in the proposals should it be deemed in the best interest of the Borough to do so.
- **B.** In case of failure by the successful proposer, the Borough of Kenilworth may procure the articles or services from other sources, deduct the cost of the replacement from money due to the proposer under the contract and hold the proposer responsible for any excess cost occasioned thereby.
- C. The proposer shall maintain sufficient insurance to protect against all claims under Workmen's Compensation, General, Professional and Automobile Liability.
- **D.** Each proposal must be signed by the person authorized to do so.
- **E.** The contract shall be in effect through December 31, 2021 unless otherwise stated.
- F. Proposals may be hand delivered or mailed consistent with the provisions of the legal notice to proposers. In the case of mailed proposals, the Borough assumes no responsibility for proposals received after the designated date and time and will return late proposals unopened. Proposals will not be accepted by facsimile or e-mail. Proposals shall be in a sealed envelope, marked "Proposal for Planning Board Attorney Services" To be considered, proposals shall be delivered to or received by the Administrator by no later than 3:00 pm on October 28, 2020
- **G.** Proposers are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. See attached exhibit A.
- H. By submission of the proposal, the proposer certifies that the service to be furnished will not infringe upon any valid patent, trademark or copyright and the successful proposer shall, at its expense, defend any and all actions or suits charging such infringement, and will save the Borough harmless in any case of any such infringement.
- I. No proposer shall influence, or attempt to influence, or cause to be influenced, any Borough officer or employee to use his/her official capacity in any manner which might tend to impair the objectivity or independence of judgment of said officer or employee.
- J. No proposer shall cause or influence, or attempt to cause or influence, any Borough officer or employee to use his/her official capacity to secure unwarranted privileges or advantages for the proposer or any other person.

- **K.** Should any difference arise between the contracting parties as to the meaning or intent of these instructions or specifications, the Borough Counsel's decision shall be final and conclusive.
- L. The Borough of Kenilworth shall not be responsible for any expenditure of monies or other expenses incurred by the proposer in making its proposal.
