June 1: Solemn Mass of St Padre Pio at the Church of St Theresa, at 3 pm

June 4: Primary Election, be advised we have new voting booths, if you have not gotten a chance to look at the new voting machines give yourself some time when going in to vote and ask questions on how to use them.

June 3-7: Restaurant Week!

June 6: 75th Anniversary of "Operation Overlord", also known as "D-Day" 156,000 American, British and Canadian forces landed on five beaches off the coast of France.

June 7: Battle of Connecticut Farms Remembrance day. Kenilworth's Proclamation giving our Borough recognition for being a part of the Battle of Connecticut Farms in 1780. While it was not "Kenilworth" at that time, in and around our Borough the Militia was responsible for halting an advance of 5000 Hessians en route to Morristown to attack Washington's Continental Army.

June 8 from 7:30 am to 10:30 am at Blackbrook park the Kenilworth PBA local 135 will host it's 29th Annual Fishing Derby. Registration is mandatory and open to all school age children between 3 and 12 years old.

June 14: Flag Day, on this day we honor the adoption of our Nations Flag and wish Happy Birthday to the United States Army formed on this day in 1775.

June 16: Happy Father's Day! Dad's it's your turn this month, here's to all you Dad's out there.

June 21: Last day of school for the kids! Please be careful driving around town. Congratulations to all the graduates!
