Inspections requiring more than 1 re-inspection will be required to pay a second fee.

IF YOUR HOME HAS BATTERY OPERATED SMOKE DETECTORS THIS APPLIES:

****PLEASE NOTE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2019:**** Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:70-4.19: Ten year sealed battery powered single station smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are now required. Electric powered single or multiple station smoke and carbon monoxide alarms shall not be replaced with battery detectors.

THEREFORE, ALL NON-SEALED BATTERY OPERATED SMOKE AND CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTORS MUST BE REPLACED.
