

**SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-188

WHEREAS, the Borough of Kenilworth is in need for a part-time Fire Prevention Official in the Bureau of Fire Prevention; and

WHEREAS, the Fire Chief has recommended **CARMEN GIORDINO** be appointed as Fire Prevention Official, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that **CARMEN GIORDINO** is qualified to fill all the requirements of the position of Fire Prevention Official;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Kenilworth that;

1. Carmen Giordino be appointed Fire Prevention Official effective July 26, 2023 on a part-time basis not to exceed 25 hours.
2. Carmen Giordino shall receive an annual salary of \$46,818.00 paid on a weekly basis.
3. This part-time position is entitled to benefits as set forth in the Employee Handbook.
4. This resolution shall be ratified back to July 26, 2023.
