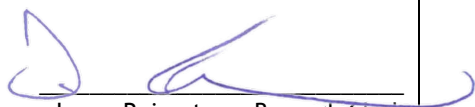
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Kenilworth, County of Union, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. Effective January 20, 2025, **Quinn Lonergan** be appointed **Dispatcher** at a starting salary of \$39,723.00 per annum in accordance with the Dispatcher Salary Schedule of Steps.
2. As a Dispatcher, Quinn Lonergan will be entitled to the benefits of and subject to the policies and procedures outlined in the Borough of Kenilworth Employee Handbook and the Kenilworth Police Department Rules and Regulations covering Dispatchers.
3. This offer of employment is contingent upon successful completion of Borough's required pre-employment screenings. This position is also subject to a six (6) month probationary period which will begin on the first date of employment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough of Kenilworth's Chief Financial Officer has certified that sufficient uncommitted funds are available in the 2025 Borough of Kenilworth Temporary Budget for the purposes set forth herein.
