

ORDINANCE 2023-8

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING PART II, GENERAL LEGISLATION, CHAPTER 190, VEHICLE AND TRAFFIC, ARTICLE III, OPERATION OF VEHICLES, SECTION 11, ONE-WAY STREETS, TO CHANGE THE TWO-WAY STREET DESIGNATING OF NORTH 20th STREET TO A ONE-WAY DESIGNATION FROM WASHINGTON STREET TO MONROE STREET, NORTHBOUND IN THE BOROUGH OF KENILWORTH

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 39:4-197(1)c, a municipality may pass an ordinance designating one-way streets without the approval of the Commissioner of the Department of Transportation; and,

WHEREAS, it is within the police powers of the Borough of Kenilworth (Borough) to regulate municipal streets; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to change North 20th Street, from Washington Street to Monroe Street, from a two-way street into a one-way street traveling Northbound.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Kenilworth, County of Union, State of New Jersey that the Code of the Borough of Kenilworth is hereby supplemented as follows:

SECTION 1. That Part II, General Legislation, Chapter 190, Vehicle and Traffic, Article III, Operation of Vehicles, Section 11, One-Way Streets, of the General Ordinances of the Borough of Kenilworth, New Jersey, as amended and supplemented, be amended by designating the following two-way street as one-way street:

Name of Street	Direction of Travel
North 20 th Street – from Washington St. to Monroe St.	Northbound

SECTION 2. The provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable and if any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof for any reason be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, subsections, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance, but shall remaining in effect; it being the legislative intent that this Ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or portions thereof in conflict or inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, but only however, or the extent of such conflict or inconsistency, it being legislative intent that all ordinances or portions of ordinances now existing or in effect shall remain in effect unless the they are in conflict or inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication and in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.


SECTION 5. This ordinance does not require approval by the Commissioner of Transportation.
