

ORDINANCE 2023-22

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 202, “FEES,” SECTION 2, “FEES,” AND CHAPTER 212, “SANITARY STANDARDS,” ARTICLE XIII, “LICENSE AND FEE SCHEDULE,” SECTION 26, “FEES ENUMERATED” OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF KENILWORTH.

WHEREAS, on February 16, 1978, the Borough of Kenilworth Municipal Council adopted Ordinance No. 3, which governs the licensing of food and beverage vending within the Borough of Kenilworth; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Kenilworth Municipal Council finds that it is in the best interests of the Borough and its citizenry to amend and modify such sections of its Fees as set forth in the Borough Code so that they are more consistent with the updated fees; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:48-1, the governing body of a municipality may make, amend, repeal, and enforce such other ordinances, regulations, rules and by-laws not contrary to the laws of this State or Federal Government, as it may deem necessary and proper for the good of government, order and protection of person and property, and for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants, and as may be necessary to carry into effect the powers and duties conferred and imposed by this subtitle, or by any law; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Kenilworth in the County of Union, State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. The foregoing whereas clause is incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2. Chapter 202, “Fees,” Section 2, “Fees,” shall be amended as follows.

§ 202-2 Designation of appropriate authority.

A. ~~The fees for licenses as required by § 202-1 above, for the purpose of raising revenue, for regulation and control, to be paid annually to this municipality, are hereby fixed as follows:~~
\$5 per machine per year.

B. All licenses issued under authority of this chapter shall expire on the last day of February of each year. License fees shall be paid to the Board of Health.

SECTION 3. Chapter 212, “Sanitary Standards,” Article XIII, “License and Fee Schedule,” Section 26, “Fees enumerated,” shall be amended as follows.

§ 212-26 Fees enumerated.

G. Miscellaneous.

- (1) Ice: \$10.
- (2) Ice cream: \$10.
- (3) Ice cream truck: \$100.
- (4) Lunch truck: \$200.
- (5) Milk: \$10.
- (6) (Reserved)
- (7) Incinerator permit: \$100.
- (8) Laundries, laundrettes, dry-cleaning establishments: \$100.
- (9) Vending permit: \$80 100.

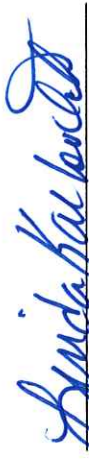
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- (10) Vending license stamps, each: \$8 10.
- (11) Wholesale: \$100.
- (12) Boarding homes for children: \$25.
- (13) Barber and beauty shops/salons: \$35.
- (14) Lodging house, per year: \$10.
- (15) Massage and body work therapies: \$225.

SECTION 4. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, or provision so adjudged and the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain valid and effective.

SECTION 5. Any ordinances or parts thereof in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to law.
