### Borough Approved Tree List Tree Trunk Caliper must be 2"-3"

*Acer Campestre*, Hedge Maple 25-35 feet: Excellent lawn or street tree. Slow growing, rounded, dense habit, dark green leaves turn yellow in fall.

*Acer ginnala*, Amur Maple 15-25 feet: Popular specimen or screen tree. Dark glossy green leaves turn yellow and red in fall. Rounded form tends toward multi-stemmed character.

*Acer Japonicum*, 'Aconitifolium' Fullmoon Maple 8 – 10 feet: Refined textured tree with deeply cut leaves that turn brilliant crimson in fall, rounded habit.

*Acer Palmatum*, Japanese Maple 15-25 feet: A great landscape tree used as an accent, grouping, or border. Many cultivars are available with red or green foliage.

*Cladastris Kentukea*, Yellowwood 30-50 feet: Excellent tree for shade. Pendent white fragrant flowers in late-May – early June. Bright green leaves turn yellow in fall.

*Cornus Florida*, Flowering dogwood, 15-25 feet: A New Jersey native flowering tree used for group plantings. Dark green leaves become reddish-purple in fall. Snowy white bracts in April or May.

*Cornus Kousa*, Japanese Dogwood 20-30 feet: Handsome specimen with excellent creamy white flower. Green leaves turn scarlet in the fall with an exfoliating winter bark.

*Ornus Mas*, Corneliancherry Dogwood 10-25 feet: Excellent widespread small tree. Abundant small yellow flowers appear before the leaves in April. Interesting and edible cherry red fruit in July.

*Franklinia Alatomaha*, Franklin-tree 10-20 feet: Rare, handsome small specimen tree with smooth fluted bark. Striking large fragrant flowers of white and yellow in late summer. Dark green leaves become fiery orange and red in fall.

*Halesia Carolina*, Carolina Silverbell 20-40 feet: NJ native tree with spreading branches and scaly, plate-like bark. Pendent bell-shaped white flowers. Leaves turn yellow in fall.

*Koelreuteria Paniculata*, Goldenrain Tree 20-40 feet: Excellent small specimen tree or shade tree. Very showy yellow flowers in summer. Handsome foliage, bright green in summer, turns yellow in fall.

*Prunus Cerasifera*, '**Thundercloud**' purple leaf plum tree 15-25 feet: Upright, densely branched tree with reddish purple foliage. Pink flowers and fruit. (Currently used on the Boulevard)

*Phellodendron Amurense*, Amur Corktree 30-45 feet: Beautiful spreading tree with rounded crown. Deep green compound leaves turn yellow in fall. On mature trees ridged bark appears cork-like, adding interest.

*Pyrus Calleryana* '**Bradford**', Bradford Callery Pear Tree 30-50 feet: A very useful tree providing spring display of white blooms followed by insignificant tiny pears. Outstanding glossy green foliage turns scarlet and purple in the fall. Other superior pest free cultivars include '**Chanticleer**' and '**Redspire**'.

*Syringa Reticulata*, Japanese Lilac Tree 15-30 feet: Snowy clusters of fragrant white flowers in June. This trouble-free lilac is useful as a specimen or a street tree. Popular cultivars include '**Ivory Silk**' and '**Summer Snow**'.
